





Prairie Aviation Training Centre (PATC) will prepare you to pursue an exciting, fast-paced career as a commercial pilot, while learning in a supportive Christian environment. With a unique focus on training pilots for the mission field, the program will also equip you for any career in aviation.

PATC's two-year aviation program is composed of flight training and Bible classes at Prairie College. As a graduate you will earn an Associate of Arts in Mission Aviation, a Commercial Pilot License with a multi-engine instrument rating and an average of 230 logged flight hours.

One-Year Certificate — Bible Two-Year Diploma — Bible Four-Year Degree — Theology Also Available Online

In our increasingly pluralistic world, the Church needs Christians who can think well and in a distinctively Christian way. This program is for students seeking deep immersion in biblical teaching and Christian thought. Grow in knowledge of the basic storyline of Scripture and the doctrinal distinctives of Christianity. Learn to competently interpret both testaments of Scripture in their literary, historical and theological contexts. Learn the Bible's relevance in contemporary faith and practice. Hone maturity as a disciple of Christ in community.

The two year Diploma covers the whole Bible in two years – the one of the only undergraduate program in North America to do so along with foundations of leadership and psychology. Students can seamlessly transfer into any degree program at Prairie from here.

Develop research and writing skills appropriate to theological and biblical studies through academic and practical study in both a three credit practicum and a written thesis project in the 4th year.

The Bachelor of Theology degree offers advanced credit to study with Canada Institute of Linguistics at Trinity Western University.

CHRISTIAN FORMATION

Two-Year Diploma Four-Year Degree

The diploma program offers a foundation for basic, discerning spiritual care for others. At the same time, it deepens your own personal transformation into the likeness of Jesus Christ. The degree program carves out a pathway for credentialing and graduate level training in a range of people-helping careers, while building on the spiritual foundations of the diploma program.

Cultivate a listening life through meditation on the Word and works of God. Learn from the wisdom of the church through the centuries. Learn to integrate Christian theological psychology with empirical research to appraise contemporary therapies. Develop an understanding of the theoretical and practical foundations of counselling and develop practical skills in becoming a "skilled helper".

Students will graduate from the degree program with "level 1" certification in spiritual direction from Urban Sanctuary which include the opportunity to learn from and work with experienced evangelical Christian counsellors and spiritual directors. Complete a 9–credit internship.

OFF-CAMPUS EXPERIENCE

In the fall of your second year, you can spend seven weeks learning about God through the beauty of His handiwork in the Canadian Rock Mountains at Frontier Lodge. This experience will shape your soul, mind and body.

TRANSFER OPPORTUNITIES

Prairie has developed a formal transfer agreement with Briercrest Seminary that provides 12 advanced credits into their Masters of Counselling or Master of Marriage and Family Therapy programs.



Learn to serve God and others by providing pastoral service in a variety of contexts. Expand your biblical literacy, learn to reflect theologically on life and ministry, become conversant with a Christian worldview and apply this knowledge into pastoral ministry in a culturally relevant manner. Develop techniques in the art and science of preaching. Develop skills in interpreting Scripture using interpretation and context within key books of the Bible as tools. Learn how to provide Godly counsel and leadership to others.

The two year diploma provides the ideal opportunity to discern if pastoral work is an appropriate life calling for you. The four year degree prepares you for future seminary studies. All students will complete a 12 credit Pastoral internship – often at their home church. A week long Proactive Ministry Retreat (PMR) at Kerith Creek Retreat Centers is also expected in the four year degree program.

Prairie has developed a pathway to a Master of Divinity degree for graduates of this degree with Carey Theological College. Carey offers formal transfer agreements for Prairie undergraduate credits which reduce the duplication of study, the credits required, and the time to complete both degrees. Discover the world of contemporary youth ministry: examine youth culture, various models of youth ministry, and the biblical and theological foundations of reaching and discipling youth. Further develop an understanding of the issues facing youth in today's culture. You will learn how to design curriculum, develop creative teaching methods, become better equipped to speak into the lives of teens with discernment and effectiveness. The four year degree program provides a deeper dive into human development with emphasis on childhood through adolescence.

All students will complete a 12 credit Youth Ministry internship – often at their home church. A week long Proactive Ministry Retreat (PMR) at Kerith Creek Retreat Centers is also expected in the four year degree program.

Four-Year Degrees Also Available Online

Prepare yourself to make a difference in the world of injustice, greed and poverty. Study the whole Bible, as well as the nature of God and His mission in the world. Hone the qualities required to thrive cross-culturally including confidence, maturity, contentment and advanced communication skills. Spend a full year overseas in the GlobeTREK internship (3rd year) which includes a six month internship with an NGO at a location of your choice. You will work and study under the leadership of seasoned mentors as well as study the local language. You may choose to obtain a Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) Certification by graduation.

GLOBETREK

An eight-month, around-the-world internship that spans at least 10 countries and five continents, completed in the third year of study.

This internship is open to all Prairie College students; however, there is an extensive application and interview process for acceptance into the GlobeTREK year.

The cost is dependent on internship choice, credits taken, travel, health insurance rates, vaccinations and other expenses.

Join this leadership incubator in the Canadian Rockies that emphasizes student leadership, experiential education and Bible integration with real life. Theses Programs are structured with time spent in the mountains at Frontier Lodge as well as on Prairie College campus. Learn technical backcountry and adventure skills like:

- Backpacking
- Rock and ice climbing
- Mountain biking

- Whitewater canoeing
- Winter survival

Graduate certified in Search and Rescue, Adventure Medicine and Field Leading. The emphasis in second year is on becoming "excellent Kingdom-focused outdoor instructors". You will be equipped to take the Professional Mountain Bike Guide (Level 1) exam after second year. In the fourth year, complete a vetted, personalized internship suited to your goals and interests.

One-Year Certificate Fall Start Date only

In this popular and competitive program, you'll learn how to assess, diagnose and treat patients in a variety of medical and trauma emergencies, as well as gain a biblical foundation that will support your long-term success in the field.

The program is offered in partnership with Professional Associates (PMA) and is accredited by the Alberta College of Paramedics (ACP), allowing graduates to work across Canada. Successful completion of the program will provide eligibility to write the Canadian Organization of Paramedic Regulators (COPR) exam and register with ACP.

The first semester of the certificate is spent completing Bible courses. In January you would finish the First Medical Responder (FMR) course before continuing on to the Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) portion of the course for which students must fulfill these further requirements.



PRACTICAL NURSING

Two-Year Diploma Fall Start Date

Offered in partnership with Red Deer Polytechnic, this program combines Prairie's Diploma in Ministry with a Diploma in Practical Nursing. Intensive and competitive, learners will train to become proficient and secure Christfollowers in the fast-paced field of medicine.

Learn at Prairie's Three Hills campus, equipped with a 16-bed hospital and simulation lab, and a state-of-the-art nursing manikin (lifelike patient simulator).

Develop your knowledge in anatomy and physiology, applied pharmacology, nursing arts, nursing foundations, health education, maternity, pediatric, mental health and community nursing (list not exhaustive). Learn skills like catheterization, tracheostomy care, wound care, injection/IV initiation and more. Your training will equip you to write the Canadian Practical Nurse Registration Exam (CPNRE). Your biblical training will provide a Christ-centered foundation for your skills.

An optional international preceptorship is being offered depending on student interest.

- A video submission detailing your educational experience and interest in the program.
- Applicants without an undergraduate degree with significant life and work experience may be evaluated for flexible admission into the program.

Bible co-requisite: To graduate with this credential, learners must have completed nine credits of eligible biblical study, either before or during their Masters study. Courses can be taken through Prairie College at a reduced rate.
