DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

General responsibilities may include but are not limited to those noted below. The description may be adjusted according to the experience, skills and passions of the successful candidate.

- Building and system electrical systems troubleshooting and repairs
- Electrical repairs and troubleshooting on heating and cooling systems including steam and hot water boilers, forced air furnaces, tube heaters, HVAC systems, air handling units, air conditioners, building management systems
- Troubleshooting and maintaining campus Fire alarm panels, networks and detectors
- Installing and maintaining building access control and security systems
- Assessing and advising on existing electrical systems
- Planning, in cooperation with the Director of Facilities, and executing new electrical projects and upgrades
- Responsible for, or to, the Annual Electrical Maintenance Permit including application, tracking and semi-annual inspections
- Willingness to complete general facility maintenance as time allows
- Assist other Maintenance Staff as requested
- Assist with setting up for College events
- Willingness to be part of on-call rotation
